



UMA/UPQC Tip of the Week “Diabetes: Eye Exam”

Background

In order to improve the Clinical Care for an At-Risk Population, patients aged 18-75 must receive either:

Retinal eye exam during the measurement period, OR

A negative retinal eye exam in the year prior to the measurement period.

How Do I Do This?

- Perform the exam in your office, reviewed by an eye care professional (optometrist/ophthalmologist)
- Obtain the documentation from an eye care professional

How Do I Get Credit?

Document in CareScreen in the Quality Registry under “DM: Eye Exam”

AND

Bill using Code CPT II 2022F (dilated eye exam performed and documentation reviewed)

Bill using Code CPT II 3072F (negative eye exam performed in the prior year)
