Tip of the Week

“Documentation of Current Medications in the Medical Record”

Background

In order to improve Care Coordination and Patient Safety, record all medications (including OTC, supplements, etc.), including name, dose, frequency and date of administration, on each visit.

CareScreen will show a red “Due” button in the quality registry on each visit.

Note that per ACO measure specifications, providers are required to complete this measure on every eligible visit.

How Do I Do This?

Document this information in the medical record and submit the proper “G” code with your claim

How Do I Get Credit?

Document in your medical record including the medication section of your chart

AND

Code G8427 (obtained, updated, or reviewed the patient’s current medications)

OR

Code G8430 (not obtained, updated, nor reviewed the patient’s medications for unspecified reason)
