



UMA/UPQC Tip of the Week “Mammography Screening”

Background

In order to improve Preventive Health, all women aged 50-75 years should be screened for breast cancer within 27 months.

The measure requires documentation on an annual basis of the date of service of the screening in the current year or documentation that the screening occurred at least once within the 27 months prior to the date of the office encounter.

How Do I Do This?

Order and receive document of this test in the medical record

How Do I Get Credit?

Document in your medical record

AND

Document in CareScreen under “Breast Cancer Screening” with the correct date

AND

Submit CPT II code 3014F (screening mammography results documented and reviewed)
