



# UMA/UPQC Tip of the Week “Medication Reconciliation”

## Background

In order to improve Care Coordination and Patient Safety, providers document for all patients seen within thirty (30) days of discharge from any inpatient facility that the medication list was reconciled with the current medication list in the outpatient medical record

## How Do I Do This?

Document this information in the medical record and submit the proper F-Code when billing

## How Do I Get Credit?

Document in your medical record “reconciled the current and discharge meds”

**AND**

Code 1111F (medication reconciliation performed)

**OR**

Code 1111F-8P (medication reconciliation Not performed, for unspecified reason)
